1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 10-13-06 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to the distribution of electric cooperative capital credits.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 10-13-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **10-13-06.** Use of revenue - Dividends - Capital credits payable upon death of

7 member. The revenues of an electric cooperative shall must be devoted first to the payment of 8 operating and maintenance expenses and the principal and interest on outstanding obligations, 9 and thereafter, to such the reserves for improvement, new construction, depreciation, and 10 contingencies as the board of directors from time to time may prescribe. Revenues not 11 required for the purposes set forth in this section shall must be returned from time to time to the 12 members of the cooperative in cash, in abatement of current charges for electrical energy, or 13 otherwise as the board of directors may determine on a pro rata basis according to the amount 14 of business done with each during the period. Such The return may be made by way of 15 general rate reduction to the members if the board of directors so elects. The cooperative shall 16 pay off any capital credits in full upon the death of a member. Unpaid capital credits accrue 17 interest at the rate of three percent per annum compounded annually until the capital credits 18 are paid to the member's estate or the member's beneficiaries.
