## Fifty-ninth Legislative Assembly of North Dakota In Regular Session Commencing Tuesday, January 4, 2005

HOUSE BILL NO. 1395 (Representatives Hanson, Mueller, Nelson, Porter)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 20.1-02-24 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to compensation of the members of the state game and fish advisory board.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-02-24 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

**20.1-02-24. Compensation.** Each member of the advisory board is entitled to be paid a per diem of <u>fifty sixty-two</u> dollars <u>and fifty cents</u> for each day of service in going to, attending, and returning from the meetings required by section 20.1-02-25 to be held in that person's respective district and the meetings of the advisory board. Each member is entitled to be reimbursed for necessary and actual expenses at the rates and in the manner provided by law for other state officers. The compensation and expenses must be paid out of department appropriations.
