A BILL for an Act to create an education congress and to provide for a legislative council study
of the state's elementary and secondary education system.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY - NORTH DAKOTA EDUCATION 5 **CONGRESS - REPORT.** During the 2005-06 interim, the legislative council shall study the 6 state's elementary and secondary education system, including key measurements of student 7 progress, programs that address the state's competitiveness with other states, and the most 8 effective means of using taxpayer dollars at the state and local levels to ensure the best 9 possible education for the children of this state. The legislative council shall also evaluate 10 effective programs; opportunities for achievement; and statutory, regulatory, and political 11 barriers to success. The legislative council shall create an education congress to receive input 12 from teachers; administrators; parents; students; local business and community leaders; 13 representatives of higher education; representatives of the executive branch; and technology, 14 curricular, and programmatic consultants, among others. The listed individuals and entities 15 shall review the state's elementary and secondary education system, evaluate the effectiveness 16 of existing programs, identify methods to increase student achievement in the state, and 17 prioritize for the legislative council the state's primary needs and goals for elementary and 18 secondary education. The legislative council shall report its findings and recommendations, 19 together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixtieth 20 legislative assembly.
