1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 20.1-04-15 and 20.1-08-04.9 of the North

2 Dakota Century Code, relating to the opening date of pheasant season for youth.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-04-15 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

20.1-04-15. Pheasant season - Opening. The open or lawful season on pheasant
and the open or lawful season on duck may not commence on the same weekend. The Except
as provided in section 20.1-08-04.9 for the opening of pheasant season for youth, the open or
lawful season on pheasant may not open earlier than one-half hour before sunrise and the
season may not commence earlier than the first Saturday of October of any given year.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-08-04.9 of the North Dakota Century Code
is amended and reenacted as follows:

13 20.1-08-04.9. Small game proclamation - Pheasants. The governor, in the 14 governor's proclamation, shall prohibit a nonresident from hunting for the first seven days of the 15 pheasant season on land owned or private land enrolled by the department for the purposes of 16 hunting or on land for which the department pays in lieu of tax payments. The governor, in the 17 governor's proclamation, shall provide that the open or lawful season on pheasant is open not 18 earlier than one-half hour before sunrise on the Friday before the opening of the regular 19 pheasant season for youth ages twelve through sixteen who are hunting with an adult. To be 20 eligible to hunt pheasant under this provision, a youth must possess a certificate of completion 21 for a certified hunter education course. The youth may only hunt under the supervision of an 22 adult who is licensed to hunt small game in this state. An adult accompanying a youth under 23 this provision may not carry a firearm in the field on the Friday before the opening of the regular

24 pheasant season.
