1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-21-41.4 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to the use of safety belts; and to repeal section 39-21-41.5 of the North Dakota Century

3 Code, relating to secondary enforcement of safety belt violations.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-21-41.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 39-21-41.4. Use of safety belts required in certain motor vehicles - Enforcement -**Evidence.** Subject to the limitations of this section and section 39-21-41.5, a driver may not 8 9 operate upon a highway a motor vehicle designed for carrying fewer than eleven passengers, 10 which was originally manufactured with safety belts unless each front seat occupant is wearing 11 a properly adjusted and fastened safety belt. This section does not apply to a child in a child 12 restraint or seatbelt in accordance with section 39-21-41.2; to drivers of implements of 13 husbandry; to operators of farm vehicles as defined in subsection 5 of section 39-04-19; to rural 14 mail carriers while on duty delivering mail; to an occupant with a medical or physically disabling condition that prevents appropriate restraint in a safety belt, if a qualified physician states in a 15 16 signed writing the nature of the condition and the reason restraint is inappropriate; or when all 17 front seat safety belts are in use by other occupants. A physician who, in good faith, provides a 18 statement that restraint would be inappropriate is not subject to civil liability. A violation for not 19 wearing a safety belt under this section is not, in itself, evidence of negligence. The fact of a 20 violation of this section is not admissible in any proceeding other than one charging the 21 violation.

SECTION 2. REPEAL. Section 39-21-41.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is
repealed.
