

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3005

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the utilization of land owned by
2 state agencies and institutions, the best use of state-owned land, and whether the state should
3 establish an inventory of state-owned land.

4 **WHEREAS**, during budget tours of state institutions during the 2003-04 interim, budget
5 tour groups received information regarding the utilization of state-owned land; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the budget tour groups identified land that is not currently utilized for
7 institutional needs; and

8 **WHEREAS**, a study of this issue could result in putting some land owned by the state to
9 better use; and

10 **WHEREAS**, a review of how state land was acquired is needed to determine what
11 options are available for the future use of the property; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the establishment of an inventory of state agency-owned and
13 institution-owned lands and the designation of a single agency to manage these lands may
14 benefit the state;

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
16 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

17 That the Legislative Council study the utilization of land owned by state agencies and
18 institutions, the best use of state-owned land, and whether the state should establish an
19 inventory of state-owned land; and

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
21 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
22 the Sixtieth Legislative Assembly.
