1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the veterans' home
2 and department of veterans' affairs; and to provide legislative intent.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION.** The amounts identified in this
5 section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the veterans' home and
6 department of veterans' affairs in section 3 of this Act as follows:

23 defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending

16 be realized from changes in the policy.
