HOUSE BILL NO. 1096 (Transportation Committee) (At the request of the Department of Transportation)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 39-10-07.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to interference with official traffic control devices.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-10-07.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

**39-10-07.3.** Interference with official traffic-control device or railroad sign or signal. No A person may not, without lawful authority, attempt to or in fact alter, deface, injure, knock down, or remove, or interfere with the operation of any official traffic-control device or any railroad sign or signal or any inscription, shield, or insignia thereon, or any other part thereof.
