

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4027

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the need for dementia-related
2 services, standards, and practices for caregivers and funding for programs and services for
3 individuals with dementias.

4 **WHEREAS**, individuals with dementias need specialized services; and

5 **WHEREAS**, there are more than 6,000 individuals in North Dakota with dementias; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the training of caregivers needs to be at a high standard to protect these
7 incapacitated individuals; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the need for specialized services for demented individuals is unknown and
9 the need appears not to be met; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the needs of individuals with dementias may require specialized programs
11 and services to increase their quality of life;

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**
13 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

14 That the Legislative Council study the need for dementia-related services, standards,
15 and practices for caregivers and funding for programs and services for individuals with
16 dementias; and

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
18 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
19 the Sixtieth Legislative Assembly.
