1 A concurrent resolution designating Senate and House employment positions and fixing  
2 compensation.

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF**  
4 **REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

5 That for the Sixty-first Legislative Assembly, the following positions are designated as  
6 employee positions of the Senate and House and are to be paid the daily wages indicated:

23           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that each employee of the Sixty-first Legislative  
24 Assembly is entitled to an additional \$1 per day for each previous regular session of the  
25 Legislative Assembly during which that employee was paid for at least 45 days, as either an  
26 employee of the Senate or the House, and to receive this additional compensation, which may  
27 not exceed \$10 per day, that employee must certify to the Legislative Council the year of each  
28 regular session during which that employee was employed as required by this resolution; and

29           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that each majority leader and each minority leader is  
30 entitled to one administrative assistant and two staff assistants, but each majority or minority  
31 leader may hire fewer or more assistants so long as the total daily compensation for the

1 assistants hired does not exceed the total daily amount authorized for those positions by this  
2 resolution; and

3 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the report of the Employment Committee of the  
4 respective house identify the number of employees in each position by listing every employee  
5 and the position for which employed; and

6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that with the approval of the Employment Committee of  
7 the respective house, a position may be converted to a part-time position, with the daily  
8 compensation converted to a per hour rate of pay, and a part-time employee may hold more  
9 than one part-time position so long as the positions held do not exceed a full-time equivalent  
10 position; and

11 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that if any employee resigns, is discharged, or for other  
12 reasons terminates employment, the compensation provided by this resolution for that  
13 employee ceases effective the last day of employment.
