- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 and subdivision a of subsection 7 of
- 2 section 54-03-20 and subsection 1 of section 54-35-10 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 3 relating to compensation and expense reimbursement of members of the legislative assembly;
- 4 to provide an effective date; and to declare an emergency.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 54-03-20 of the North Dakota
7 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

8	1.	Each member of the legislative assembly is entitled to receive as compensation for
9		services the sum of one hundred twenty-five thirty dollars for each calendar day
10		during any organizational, special, or regular legislative session and for each day
11		that member attends a meeting of a legislative committee between the
12		organizational session and the regular session as authorized by legislative rule.
13	SEC	CTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 54-03-20 of the North Dakota
14	Century Co	de is amended and reenacted as follows:
15	1.	Each member of the legislative assembly is entitled to receive as compensation for
16		services the sum of one hundred thirty thirty-five dollars for each calendar day
17		during any organizational, special, or regular legislative session and for each day
18		that member attends a meeting of a legislative committee between the
19		organizational session and the regular session as authorized by legislative rule.
20	SEC	CTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subdivision a of subsection 7 of section 54-03-20 of the
21	North Dako	ta Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
22	7.	a. In addition, each member is entitled to receive during the term for which the
23		member was elected, as compensation for the execution of public duties

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1	during the biennium, the sum of three hundred fifty sixty-four dollars a month,	
2	which is payable every six months or monthly, at the member's option.	
3	SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Subdivision a of subsection 7 of section 54-03-20 of the	
4	North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:	
5	7. a. In addition, each member is entitled to receive during the term for which the	
6	member was elected, as compensation for the execution of public duties	
7	during the biennium, the sum of three hundred sixty four seventy-eight dollars	
8	a month, which is payable every six months or monthly, at the member's	
9	option.	
10	SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 54-35-10 of the North Dakota	
11	Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:	
12	1. The members of the council and the members of any committee of the council are	
13	entitled to be compensated for the time spent in attendance at sessions of the	
14	council and of its committees at the rate of one hundred four dollars per day and	
15	must also be paid for expenses incurred in attending said meetings and in the	
16	performance of their official duties in the amounts provided by law for other state	
17	officers.	
18	SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 54-35-10 of the North Dakota	
19	Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:	
20	1. The members of the council and the members of any committee of the council are	
21	entitled to be compensated for the time spent in attendance at sessions of the	
22	council and of its committees at the rate of one hundred four eight dollars per day	
23	and must also be paid for expenses incurred in attending said meetings and in the	
24	performance of their official duties in the amounts provided by law for other state	
25	officers.	
26	SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE. Sections 1, 3, and 5 of this Act become effective on	
27	July 1, 2007, and sections 2, 4, and 6 of this Act become effective on July 1, 2008.	
28	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY. Sections 1, 3, and 5 of this Act are declared to be an	
29	emergency measure.
