1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 3 of section 12.1-32-07 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to the conditions of probation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 3 of section 12.1-32-07 of the North Dakota
Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 The court shall provide as an explicit condition of every probation that the 3. 7 defendant may not possess a firearm, destructive device, or other dangerous 8 weapon while the defendant is on probation and. Except when the offense is a 9 misdemeanor offense under section 12.1-17-01, 12.1-17-01.1, 12.1-17-05, or 10 12.1-17-07.1, or chapter 14-07.1, the court may waive this condition of probation if 11 the defendant has pled guilty to, or has been found guilty of, a misdemeanor or 12 infraction offense, the misdemeanor or infraction is the defendant's first offense, 13 and the court has made a specific finding on the record before imposition of a 14 sentence or a probation that there is good cause to waive the condition. The court 15 may not waive this condition of probation if the court places the defendant under 16 the supervision and management of the department of corrections and 17 rehabilitation. The court shall provide as an explicit condition of probation that the 18 defendant may not willfully defraud a urine test administered as a condition of 19 probation. Unless waived on the record by the court, the court shall also provide 20 as a condition of probation that the defendant undergo various agreed-to 21 community constraints and conditions as intermediate measures of the department 22 of corrections and rehabilitation to avoid revocation, which may include: 23 a. Community service; 24 b. Day reporting;
