1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 57-35.3-05, a new section to

2 chapter 57-38, and a new subsection to section 57-38-30.3 of the North Dakota Century Code,

3 relating to a financial institution's tax credit and a corporate and individual income tax credit for

4 contributions to community endowment funds; and to provide an effective date.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 57-35.3-05 of the North Dakota Century Code 7 is created and enacted as follows:

8	There is allowed a credit against the tax imposed by sections 57-35.3-01 through			
9	57-35.3-12 in an amount equal to twenty percent of the aggregate amount of			
10	contributions made by the taxpayer during the taxable year to a community			
11	endowment fund as provided under section 2 of this Act. The amount allowable as			
12	a credit under this subsection for any taxable year may not exceed five and			
13	seven-tenths percent of the tax before credits allowed under this section. Any			
14	unused portion of the credit may be carried forward for up to three taxable years.			
15	SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 57-38 of the North Dakota Century Code is			
16	created and enacted as follows:			
17	Credit for contributions to community endowment funds. An individual or			
18	corporation is entitled to a credit against the tax imposed under section 57-38-29, 57-38-30, or			
19	57-38-30.3 in an amount equal to twenty percent of the amount contributed during the taxable			
20	year by the taxpayer to a community endowment fund certified by the department of commerce			
21	The credit under this section may not exceed the taxpayer's tax liability under this chapter. Any			
22	unused portion of the credit may be carried forward for up to three taxable years. To be			
23	certified as a community endowment fund under this section, the fund must:			

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1	<u>1.</u>	Be	established and operated for community betterment in a defined area of this		
2		sta	state which does not include any property within the limits of any city of more than		
3		fiv	e thousand population;		
4	<u>2.</u>	Be	governed by a board of directors, each member of which is a resident of the		
5		<u>de</u>	fined area of operation of the fund;		
6	<u>3.</u>	Be	Be used to provide funding assistance for community betterment projects intended		
7		<u>to:</u>			
8		<u>a.</u>	Enhance the quality of life in the community;		
9		<u>b.</u>	Generate opportunities that will attract and retain young people and families;		
10		<u>C.</u>	Foster a cohesive and public-spirited community; or		
11		<u>d.</u>	Enhance the image or appearance of the community or tourism interest in the		
12			community; and		
13	<u>4.</u>	<u>Av</u>	oid providing funding assistance to any individual or business that does not		
14		pro	ovide approximately equal benefits to all members of the community.		
15	SECTION 3. A new subsection to section 57-38-30.3 of the North Dakota Century Code				
16	is created and enacted as follows:				
17		A taxpayer filing a return under this section is entitled to the credit provided under			
18		<u>se</u>	ction 2 of this Act.		
19	SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after				
20	December 31, 2006.
