## ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2360

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-04-10.13 of the North Dakota Century  
2 Code, relating to nonprofit organization number plates.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-04-10.13 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **39-04-10.13. Public or nonprofit organization number plate.**

- 7 1. The director shall develop an organization number plate program for distinctive  
8 number plates for qualifying public and for nonprofit organizations recognized by  
9 the internal revenue service as tax exempt under 26 U.S.C. 501(c)(3). When  
10 appropriate, the department shall design a distinctive number plate to minimize the  
11 changes to a single application of overlay on the left side of the number plate. The  
12 organization may submit a design for the distinctive number plate for approval by  
13 the director. Upon approval by the director and proper application with proof of a  
14 minimum of ~~four hundred~~ fifty applicants and a one-time payment of one thousand  
15 five hundred dollars for a certain organization's number plate, the director shall  
16 include the number plate in the organization number plate program.
- 17 2. The following organizations do not qualify for an organization number plate:  
18 out-of-state colleges and universities; groups within high schools, junior colleges,  
19 universities, and technical schools, including individual boosters, athletic boosters,  
20 and similar groups; unions; political organizations; religious organizations; groups  
21 that promote racial or social disharmony; and public offices.
- 22 3. Upon proper application for a plate in the organization number plate program and  
23 payment of all other fees required under this chapter for registration of the motor  
24 vehicle and payment of an additional annual fee of twenty-five dollars, a qualified

- 1                    applicant is entitled to issuance of a certain organization number plate. However,  
2                    the director may not issue the plates to the owner of a passenger motor vehicle or  
3                    a truck the gross weight of which equals or exceeds ten thousand pounds [4535.92  
4                    kilograms].
- 5                    4. The director shall deposit ten dollars of the additional organization number plate  
6                    fee in the highway tax distribution fund and transfer monthly fifteen dollars to the  
7                    proper organization to support programs of that organization.
