- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-03 and a new subsection to
- 2 section 20.1-03-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to hunter education

3 requirements and to hunting, fishing, and trapping privileges for active duty military members.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 20.1-03-04 of the North Dakota Century

6 Code is created and enacted as follows:

- 7 Upon presentation of valid leave papers and a valid North Dakota operator's
- 8 license, a resident who is on leave and is on active duty as a member of the United
- 9 States armed forces or the United States merchant marine may hunt small game,

10 fish, or trap during the open season without a license.

SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is
created and enacted as follows:

- 13 One-time hunter education exemption. An individual eighteen years of age or older
- 14 may receive a one-time exemption from the hunter education requirements of section
- 15 20.1-03-01.2 for up to one license year if that individual applies for the hunting license directly
- 16 from the department. A license issued to an individual under this section is valid only when the
- 17 individual is accompanied afield, and under the direct supervision of, a licensed adult who is in
- 18 compliance with section 20.1-03-01.2.
