1 A concurrent resolution designating House and Senate employment positions and fixing
2 compensation.

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**
4 **SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

5 That for the Sixtieth Legislative Assembly, the following positions are designated as
6 employee positions of the House and Senate and are to be paid the daily wages indicated:

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that each employee of the Sixtieth Legislative Assembly
25 is entitled to an additional \$1 per day for each previous regular session of the Legislative
26 Assembly during which that employee was paid for at least 45 days, as either an employee of
27 the Senate or the House, and to receive this additional compensation, which may not exceed
28 \$10 per day, that employee must certify to the Legislative Council the year of each regular
29 session during which that employee was employed as required by this resolution; and

30 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that each majority leader and each minority leader is
31 entitled to one administrative assistant and two staff assistants, but each majority or minority

1 leader may hire fewer or more assistants so long as the total daily compensation for the
2 assistants hired does not exceed the total daily amount authorized for those positions by this
3 resolution; and

4 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the report of the Employment Committee of the
5 respective house identify the number of employees in each position by listing every employee
6 and the position for which employed; and

7 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that with the approval of the Employment Committee of
8 the respective house, a position may be converted to a part-time position, with the daily
9 compensation converted to a per hour rate of pay, and a part-time employee may hold more
10 than one part-time position so long as the positions held do not exceed a full-time equivalent
11 position; and

12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that if any employee resigns, is discharged, or for other
13 reasons terminates employment, the compensation provided by this resolution for that
14 employee ceases effective the last day of employment.
