

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3047

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study grain inspection and grading
2 procedures.

3 **WHEREAS**, grain inspection and grading helps to ensure that producers get paid the
4 maximum amount for their grain according to its quality; and

5 **WHEREAS**, grain inspection and grading helps to attract and keep customers who buy
6 our grain for its consistent quality; and

7 **WHEREAS**, grain inspection and grading must be built around qualities that customers
8 want, be easily applied at both primary and terminal elevators, and be accurately, uniformly,
9 and consistently measured and interpreted; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the manner in which grain is sampled and tested and the consistency of
11 results achieved by the grain inspection and grading process have major economic
12 consequences to the grain growers of this state;

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
14 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

15 That the Legislative Council study grain inspection and grading procedures, including
16 the methodology, accuracy, uniformity, and cost-effectiveness of the procedures and the
17 process for resolving disputes; and

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
19 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
20 the Sixty-first Legislative Assembly.
