1 A concurrent resolution to create and enact a new section to article X of the Constitution of

2 North Dakota, relating to establishment and use of a permanent oil tax trust fund; and to

- 3 provide an effective date.

STATEMENT OF INTENT

5 This measure establishes a permanent oil tax trust fund and imposes limitations on use of

6 moneys in the fund.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
 8 SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

9 That the following proposed new section to article X of the Constitution of North Dakota

10 is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the general

11 election to be held in 2008, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of

12 North Dakota.

13 SECTION 1. A new section to article X of the Constitution of North Dakota is created14 and enacted as follows:

15 <u>All revenue deposited in the general fund during a biennium derived from taxes</u>

16 imposed on oil and gas at the time of production or extraction which exceeds one hundred ten

17 million dollars must be transferred by the state treasurer to a special fund in the state treasury

18 known as the permanent oil tax trust fund. The state treasurer shall transfer interest earnings

- 19 of the permanent oil tax trust fund to the general fund at the end of each fiscal year. The
- 20 principal of the permanent oil tax trust fund may not be expended except upon a vote of

21 three-fourths of the members elected to each house of the legislative assembly and not more

22 than twenty percent of the principal may be expended during any biennium.

23 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. If approved by the voters, this measure becomes
24 effective on July 1, 2009.
