

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3048

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study crime victims compensation
2 funding.

3 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation's crime victims
4 compensation fund has not received the anticipated level of federal funding; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the crime victims compensation fund has been unable to meet its financial
6 obligations in a timely manner; and

7 **WHEREAS**, other states have developed different strategies to fund crime victims
8 compensation funds;

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
10 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

11 That the Legislative Council conduct a comprehensive interim study, including a review
12 of other states' efforts, and receive input from victim advocacy groups and medical providers;
13 and

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
15 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
16 the Sixty-first Legislative Assembly.
