

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4040

1 A concurrent resolution urging Congress to repeal the REAL ID Act of 2005.

2 **WHEREAS**, the federal REAL ID Act of 2005 mandates an unfunded national driver's
3 license in the state of North Dakota; and

4 **WHEREAS**, implementation of the REAL ID Act may cost this state an estimated
5 \$14,000,000; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the REAL ID national data base will invite identity theft and invasion of
7 privacy; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the REAL ID Act will cost and inconvenience the people of North Dakota
9 without the proffered attendant benefit of protection from terrorism;

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**
11 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

12 That the Sixtieth Legislative Assembly urges the Congress of the United States to
13 repeal the REAL ID Act of 2005; and

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this
15 resolution to the President of the United States, the Secretary of Homeland Security, the
16 Secretary of the Department of Transportation, and to each member of the North Dakota
17 Congressional Delegation.
