## ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2060

Introduced by

Government and Veterans Affairs Committee

(At the request of the State Board of Plumbing)

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 43-18-05 and 43-18-24 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code, relating to plumbing board member compensation and plumbing code violations;  
3 and to provide a penalty.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-18-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **43-18-05. Members of board and employees - Compensation.** Each appointed  
8 member of the board ~~shall is entitled to receive twenty dollars per day for each day actually~~  
9 ~~engaged~~ compensation in an amount determined by the board for actual services rendered in  
10 the performance of the member's duties under this chapter, and ~~all members~~ each member  
11 and employee of the board, ~~and all employees thereof, shall is entitled to receive their~~ traveling  
12 expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties. Allowances for traveling expenses  
13 must be as provided by law for state officials and employees. ~~All such~~ The compensation and  
14 expense must be paid out of the state plumbing board fund. The compensation provided for in  
15 this section may not be paid to any member of the board who receives salary or other  
16 compensation as a regular employee of the state or any of its political subdivisions or any  
17 institution or industry operated by the state.

18 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-18-24 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
19 amended and reenacted as follows:

20 **43-18-24. Violation of chapter - Penalty.** Any person who violates any of the  
21 provisions of this chapter, rules adopted under this chapter, or of the state plumbing code, or  
22 who fails to do any act required by said code, is guilty of ~~an infraction~~ a class B misdemeanor,  
23 unless a different penalty is otherwise specifically provided.
