1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 23-20.3-04.1 of the North Dakota Century
2 Code, relating to underground storage tank regulations.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 23-20.3-04.1 of the North Dakota Century Code
5 is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **23-20.3-04.1. Underground storage tank regulations.** Pursuant to the requirements
7 of chapter 28-32, the department shall, after notice and opportunity for public hearing and
8 comment, adopt:

- 9 1. Regulations for maintaining a leak detection system, an inventory control system
10 together with tank testing, or a comparable system or method designed to identify
11 releases in a manner consistent with the protection of human health and the
12 environment.
- 13 2. Regulations for maintaining records of any monitoring of a leak detection system,
14 inventory control system, or tank testing system.
- 15 3. Regulations for reporting of any releases and corrective action taken in response to
16 a release from an underground tank.
- 17 4. Regulations for taking corrective action in response to a release from an
18 underground storage tank.
- 19 5. Regulations for the closure of tanks to prevent future releases of regulated
20 substances into the environment.
- 21 6. Regulations for maintaining evidence of financial responsibility for taking corrective
22 action and compensating third parties for bodily injury and property damage
23 caused by sudden and nonsudden accidental releases arising from operating an
24 underground storage tank.

- 1 7. Regulations establishing standards for installation of new underground storage
- 2 tanks.
- 3 8. Regulations establishing standards for construction and performance of new
- 4 underground storage tanks.
- 5 9. Regulations for notifying the department or designated local agency of the
- 6 existence of any operational or nonoperational underground storage tank.
- 7 10. Regulations for a permit fee system to own, install, or operate an underground
- 8 storage tank.

9 However, regulations adopted by the department may not be more stringent than applicable
10 ~~federal rules adopted pursuant to Public Law 98-616 [98 Stat. 3277; 42 U.S.C. 6991 et seq.]~~
11 requirements of the federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act and the federal Energy
12 Policy Act of 2005 in effect on August 1, 2007.
