1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 44-04-18.14 and subsection 3 of section  
2 52-01-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to release and use of information provided  
3 to the followup information on North Dakota education and training system.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 44-04-18.14 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **44-04-18.14. ~~Certain records of occupational information coordinating committee~~**  
8 **~~–Exempt Information provided to the followup information on North Dakota education~~**  
9 **~~and training system.~~** Records Except as provided in this section, information provided by  
10 participating agencies to the North Dakota occupational information coordinating committee by  
11 any person for use in the followup information on North Dakota education and training system  
12 for research or statistical purposes may ~~only~~ not be released in any manner that identifies an  
13 individual. Personally identifiable information may be used to ~~prepare~~ produce aggregate data  
14 compilations that do not identify any individual and may not be disclosed to the public by the  
15 occupational information coordinating committee. A request for disclosure of the records under  
16 section 44-04-18 or section 6 of article XI of the Constitution of North Dakota must be directed  
17 to the person or entity that has provided the records to the occupational information  
18 coordinating committee statistics and, unless prohibited by federal law, may be used by  
19 participating agencies to fulfill their obligations for state and federal statistical reporting and may  
20 not be used or released for any other purpose.

21 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 3 of section 52-01-03 of the North Dakota  
22 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

23 3. Job service North Dakota may provide workforce safety and insurance, the labor  
24 commissioner, the driver's license division of the department of transportation, the

1 department of human services, the department of commerce, the state tax  
2 commissioner, and the ~~North Dakota occupational information coordinating~~  
3 ~~committee~~ followup information on North Dakota education and training system  
4 with information obtained pursuant to the administration of the unemployment  
5 insurance program, and may enter into interagency agreements with those entities  
6 for the exchange of information that will enhance the administration of the  
7 unemployment insurance program. Any information furnished pursuant to this  
8 subsection or pursuant to interagency agreements authorized by this subsection is  
9 to be used for governmental purposes only.
