

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3022

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the availability and future need
2 for dementia-related services, as well as funding for programs for individuals with dementias.

3 **WHEREAS**, persons with dementias need specialized services; and

4 **WHEREAS**, there are more than 16,000 persons with dementias in North Dakota; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the number of persons diagnosed with dementia is rapidly increasing,
6 especially among the population age 85 and older; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the need for specialized services for individuals with dementias is
8 unknown; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the needs of individuals with dementias may require specialized services
10 for programs to increase those individuals' quality of life;

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
12 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

13 That the Legislative Council study the availability and future need for dementia-related
14 services, as well as funding for programs for individuals with dementias; and

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
17 the Sixty-first Legislative Assembly.
