1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-44.3-20 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to exempting employees of the director of mineral resources from classified service.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-44.3-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **54-44.3-20. Categories of positions in the state service.** All positions in the state
7 service are included in the classified service except:

- 8 1. Each official elected by popular vote and each person appointed to fill vacancies in
9 an elective office, one principal assistant, and one private secretary.
- 10 2. Members of boards and commissions required by law.
- 11 3. Administrative heads of departments required by law, other than the
12 superintendent of North Dakota vision services - school for the blind, the
13 superintendent of the school for the deaf, and the state librarian.
- 14 4. Officers and employees of the legislative branch of government.
- 15 5. Members of the judicial branch of government of the state of North Dakota and
16 their employees and jurors.
- 17 6. Persons temporarily employed in a professional or scientific capacity as
18 consultants or to conduct a temporary and special inquiry, investigation, or
19 examination for the legislative branch of government or a department of the state
20 government.
- 21 7. Positions deemed to be inappropriate to the classified service due to the special
22 nature of the position as determined by the division and approved by the board.
- 23 8. Employees of the institutions of higher education under the control of the state
24 board of higher education.

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- 1 9. Members and employees of occupational and professional boards.
- 2 10. Officers and employees of the North Dakota mill and elevator association.
- 3 11. The director of the committee on employment of people with disabilities of the
- 4 department of human services.
- 5 12. Positions referred to under law as serving at the pleasure of or at the will of the
- 6 appointing authority.
- 7 13. Licensed teachers engaged in teaching at the North Dakota youth correctional
- 8 center, North Dakota vision services - school for the blind, and the school for the
- 9 deaf.
- 10 14. Officers and employees of workforce safety and insurance.
- 11 15. Officers and employees of the department of commerce.
- 12 16. Attorneys employed by the insurance commissioner.
- 13 17. Employees of the director of mineral resources.
