1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-44.3-20 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to exempting engineers and geologists employed by the director of mineral resources
3 from classified service; and to declare an emergency.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-44.3-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **54-44.3-20. Categories of positions in the state service.** All positions in the state
8 service are included in the classified service except:

- 9 1. Each official elected by popular vote and each person appointed to fill vacancies in
10 an elective office, one principal assistant, and one private secretary.
- 11 2. Members of boards and commissions required by law.
- 12 3. Administrative heads of departments required by law, other than the
13 superintendent of North Dakota vision services - school for the blind, the
14 superintendent of the school for the deaf, and the state librarian.
- 15 4. Officers and employees of the legislative branch of government.
- 16 5. Members of the judicial branch of government of the state of North Dakota and
17 their employees and jurors.
- 18 6. Persons temporarily employed in a professional or scientific capacity as
19 consultants or to conduct a temporary and special inquiry, investigation, or
20 examination for the legislative branch of government or a department of the state
21 government.
- 22 7. Positions deemed to be inappropriate to the classified service due to the special
23 nature of the position as determined by the division and approved by the board.

- 1 8. Employees of the institutions of higher education under the control of the state
- 2 board of higher education.
- 3 9. Members and employees of occupational and professional boards.
- 4 10. Officers and employees of the North Dakota mill and elevator association.
- 5 11. The director of the committee on employment of people with disabilities of the
- 6 department of human services.
- 7 12. Positions referred to under law as serving at the pleasure of or at the will of the
- 8 appointing authority.
- 9 13. Licensed teachers engaged in teaching at the North Dakota youth correctional
- 10 center, North Dakota vision services - school for the blind, and the school for the
- 11 deaf.
- 12 14. Officers and employees of workforce safety and insurance.
- 13 15. Officers and employees of the department of commerce.
- 14 16. Attorneys employed by the insurance commissioner.
- 15 17. Engineers and geologists employed by the director of mineral resources.
- 16 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
