**ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1338**

1 A BILL to provide for a legislative council study of solid waste management, with an emphasis  
2 on the siting and zoning of landfills on a statewide or regional level while allowing adequate  
3 protection for political subdivisions and property owners.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY OF SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT.**

6 During the 2009-10 interim, the legislative council shall study solid waste management, with an  
7 emphasis on the siting and zoning of landfills on a statewide or regional level while allowing  
8 adequate protection for political subdivisions and property owners in the siting and zoning  
9 process. The study also may include the incorporation of information dealing with new solid  
10 waste sciences that affect the overall issue of siting. The legislative council shall report its  
11 findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the  
12 recommendations, to the sixty-second legislative assembly.
