- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new chapter to title 4.1 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to the certification of forage; to repeal section 63-01.1-12.2 of the North Dakota
- 3 Century Code, relating to weed-free certification of gravel pits and forage; to provide an
- 4 appropriation; and to declare an emergency.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1.** A new chapter to title 4.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 7 and enacted as follows:

9	<u>1.</u>	<u>To o</u>	btain o	certification that weeds prohibited according to the standards of the

11		seed	ds and	included in baled forage, the owner of the forage shall request that the
12		<u>agric</u>	culture	commissioner conduct a certification inspection.
13	<u>2.</u>	<u>Upo</u>	n rece	iving the request, the agriculture commissioner shall:
14		<u>a.</u>	Inspe	ct the forage acreage within ten days before harvest to verify that weeds
15			prohil	pited according to the standards of the North American weed
16			mana	gement association are not present and producing viable seeds; and
17		<u>b.</u>	(1)	Ascertain that the scheduled harvest has occurred;
18			<u>(2)</u>	Determine the number of bales for which certification tags must be
19				issued; and
20			<u>(3)</u>	Verify that the baled forage is stored or will be stored only in an area
21				where weeds prohibited according to the standards of the North
22				American weed management association are not present and
23				producing viable seeds.

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1	<u>3.</u>	If the agriculture commissioner determines that the conditions of subsection 2 have				
2		been met, the commissioner shall issue and affix or cause to be affixed on each				
3		bale of forage one dated certification tag.				
4	Agents of the commissioner - Designation - Training. The agriculture commissioner					
5	may designate individuals to serve as agents of the commissioner for the purpose of					
6	conducting the inspections permitted by this Act. To be designated as an agent, an individual					
7	<u>must:</u>					
8	<u>1.</u>	Be a weed control officer;				
9	<u>2.</u>	Be a member of a county or a city weed board;				
10	<u>3.</u>	Be determined by the commissioner to have a level of education and experience				
11		sufficient to accurately perform the requested certifications; or				
12	<u>4.</u>	At least once every thirty-six months, successfully complete a training program				
13		conducted by the commissioner.				
14	Reciprocal recognition of certification. The agriculture commissioner may contract					
15	with any governmental entity that is responsible for the certification of forage in another state or					
16	6 province and provide for the reciprocal recognition of such certifications.					
17	17 Fees - Continuing appropriation. The agriculture commissioner may set and charge					
18	fees for certifying forage in accordance with this chapter. The commissioner shall deposit					
19	moneys collected under this chapter in the environment and rangeland protection fund.					
20	SEC	CTION 2. REPEAL. Section 63-01.1-12.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is				
21	repealed.					

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
