- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 20.1-03-36.1 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to licensing of outfitters; to provide an expiration date; and to
- 3 declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 20.1-03-36.1 of the North Dakota
6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7 4. A license is not required for a person to provide services on real property that person owns or leases for the primary pursuit of bona fide agricultural interests or, 8 9 for a nonprofit organization registered with the secretary of state, or for a person 10 that acts as a booking agent for a person that legally conducts business as an 11 outfitter. A booking agent that refers an individual to an outfitter under this 12 subsection may receive a fee or commission for the referral. The director shall 13 determine the number of acres by county exempted from licensure by this 14 subsection and shall publish the results. The director shall provide written information to the public on the possible liability exposure for outfitting under this 15 16 subsection and on the benefits of liability insurance and proper training. For 17 purposes of this section, a booking agent means a person that receives only a fee 18 for referring or marketing the services of a legal outfitter in this state. 19 SECTION 2. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through July 31, 2011, and 20 after that date is ineffective. 21 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
