1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 65-05 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to a treating doctor's opinion in workers' compensation decisions.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 65-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 created and enacted as follows:

6 **Treating doctor's opinion.**

- 7 1. If the organization does not give an injured employee's treating doctor's opinion
8 controlling weight, the organization shall establish that the treating doctor's opinion
9 is not well-supported by medically acceptable clinical and laboratory diagnostic
10 techniques or is inconsistent with the other substantial evidence in the injured
11 employee's record based on one or more of the following factors:
- 12 a. The length of the treatment relationship and the frequency of examinations;
 - 13 b. The nature and extent of the treatment relationship;
 - 14 c. The amount of relevant evidence in support of the opinion;
 - 15 d. How consistent the opinion is with the record as a whole;
 - 16 e. Appearance of bias;
 - 17 f. Whether the doctor specializes in the medical issues related to the opinion;
18 and
 - 19 g. Other relevant factors.
- 20 2. This section does not apply to managed care programs under section 65-02-20.
21 For purposes of this section, the organization shall determine whether a doctor is
22 an injured employee's treating doctor.
