4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 26.1-36 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Telemedicine.

- 1. An insurance company, nonprofit health service corporation, or health maintenance organization may not deliver, issue, execute, or renew any hospital, surgical, medical, or major medical benefit policy on an individual, group, blanket franchise, or association basis unless the policy, contract, or evidence of coverage provides coverage for telemedicine.
- 2. Telemedicine coverage required under this section must be provided in a manner determined in consultation with the attending physician and the patient. The coverage may be subject to annual deductibles and coinsurance provisions as may be determined appropriate and as are consistent with those established for other benefits under the plan or coverage.
- 3. Coverage required under this section may not:
 - a. Deny to a patient eligibility, or continued eligibility, to enroll or to renew
 coverage under the terms of the plan, solely for the purpose of avoiding the
 requirements of this section; or
 - <u>b.</u> Penalize or otherwise reduce or limit the reimbursement of an attending
 provider, or provide incentives to an attending provider, to induce the provider
