

**HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3056**

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the powers, duties,  
2 decisionmaking role, and the terms of the members of the state child protection team and to  
3 examine the best way to collect and preserve evidence in child protective service assessments.

4 **WHEREAS**, North Dakota Century Code Chapter 50-25.1 contains the state's laws that  
5 govern child protection services; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the state child protection team plays a vital role in providing local  
7 information and expertise in child protection cases; and

8 **WHEREAS**, to protect abused and neglected children, it is essential that existing  
9 evidence in child protection assessments is collected and preserved in the best possible way;

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**  
11 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

12 That the Legislative Council study the powers, duties, decisionmaking role, and the  
13 terms of the members of the state child protection team and to examine the best way to collect  
14 and preserve evidence in child protective service assessments; and

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and  
16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to  
17 the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
