- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 6-08 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to assessment of automated teller machine access fees for foreign

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 6-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:

8	<u>1.</u>	<u>In th</u>	is section:
9		<u>a.</u>	"Automated teller machine" means any electronic information processing
10			device or electronic funds transfer facility located in this state that accepts or
11			disposes cash in connection with a credit, deposit, or other account.
12			"Automated teller machine" does not include a device that is used solely to
13			facilitate check guarantees or check authorizations, or that is used in
14			connection with the acceptance or dispensing of cash on a person-to-person
15			basis.
16		<u>b.</u>	"Foreign account" means an account with a financial institution located
17			outside the United States.
18	<u>2.</u>	<u>An a</u>	greement to operate or share an automated teller machine may not prohibit an
19		own	er or operator of the automated teller machine from imposing on an individual
20		<u>who</u>	conducts a transaction using a foreign account an access fee or surcharge
21		<u>that</u>	is not otherwise prohibited under federal or state law.
22	<u>3.</u>	<u>This</u>	Act first applies to agreements entered into, modified, or renewed after the
23		effec	ctive date of this section.
