- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 5-01 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to using false identification to obtain alcoholic beverages.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 5-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

- 6 **Proof of age Seizure of false identification.**
- 7 <u>1.</u> <u>A licensed retailer of alcoholic beverages or an employee of a licensed retailer may</u>
- 8 determine proof of age for purchasing or consuming an alcoholic beverage solely by
 9 inspection of one of the following:
- 10 <u>a.</u> <u>A valid driver's license or identification card issued by this state, another state, or</u>
 11 <u>a province of Canada which includes the photograph and date of birth of the</u>
 12 licensed individual:
- b. <u>A valid military identification card issued by the United States department of</u>
 defense; or
- 15 <u>c.</u> <u>A valid passport issued or recognized by the United States.</u>
- 16 <u>2</u>, <u>A licensed retailer or an employee of a licensed retailer may seize a form of</u>
- 17 identification displayed as proof of age if the licensed retailer or an employee of a
- 18 licensed retailer has a reasonable belief that the form of identification has been
- 19 <u>altered, falsified, or is being used to unlawfully obtain alcoholic beverages.</u>
- 20 3. Within twenty-four hours of seizing a form of identification as allowed under this
- section, a licensed retailer or an employee of a licensed retailer must notify a law
 enforcement agency of the seizure.
