1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 65-02-20.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
2 relating to workers' compensation benefits for generic drugs; to provide for a report; to provide  
3 for application; and to provide an expiration date.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 65-02-20.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted  
6 as follows:

7 **65-02-20.1. Pharmaceutical generic requirement.**

8 For all controlled substances identified under subsection 3 of section 19-03.5-01, if a  
9 generic or bioequivalent treatment becomes available and the use of the generic or  
10 bioequivalent treatment would not produce a verifiable allergic reaction, the organization shall  
11 pay for a pharmaceutical treatment not to exceed the cost of the generic or bioequivalent  
12 treatment. A dispute under this section must be resolved in the same manner as set forth under  
13 section 65-02-20.

14 **SECTION 2. REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT.** During the 2011-12 interim, the  
15 director of workforce safety and insurance or director's designee shall prepare and present a  
16 report regarding dispense as written utilization information to the legislative management.

17 **SECTION 3. APPLICATION.** This Act applies to pharmaceutical treatments occurring on or  
18 after the effective date of this Act.

19 **SECTION 4. EXPIRATION DATE.** This Act is effective through July 31, 2013, and after that  
20 date is ineffective.
