- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 50-24.4-07 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to nonallowable costs in nursing home ratesetting.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 50-24.4-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **50-24.4-07. Nonallowable costs.**

- 7 1. The following costs may not be recognized as allowable: political contributions;
- 8 salaries or expenses of a lobbyist, as defined in section 54-05.1-02, for lobbying
- 9 activities; advertising designed to encourage potential residents to select a particular
- 10 nursing home; fines and penalties; legal and related expenses for unsuccessful
- 11 challenges to decisions by governmental agencies; memberships in sports, health, or
- 12 similar social clubs or organizations; and costs incurred for activities directly related to
- 13 influencing employees with respect to unionization. The department by rule shall
- 14 exclude the costs of other items or services not directly related to the provision of
- 15 resident care.
- 16 2. Nonallowable costs include the education expense unless:
- 17 a. The education was provided by an accredited academic or technical educational
 18 facility;
- b. The education expense was for materials, books, or tuition;
- c. The facility claims the education expense, annually, in an amount not to exceed
 the lesser of one-half of the individual's education expense or three thousand
 seven hundred fifty dollars <u>for each individual</u>; and
- 23 d. The amount of education expense claimed for an individual does not exceed
 24 fifteen thousand dollars in the aggregate.

| 12 | | previously been claimed in any report year, the facility shall report the amount of |
| 13 | | repayment on the facility's cost report in the report year in which the default occurs. |
