## ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1202

1 A BILL ~~for an Act to provide an appropriation for a healthy school program grant~~for an Act to  
2 provide an appropriation for an automated external defibrillator maintenance and readiness  
3 monitoring grant.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 ~~— **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general-~~  
6 ~~fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$640,000, or so much of the~~  
7 ~~sum as may be necessary, to the state department of health for the purpose of awarding a~~  
8 ~~healthy school program grant to the southeast education cooperative regional education~~  
9 ~~association, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. Under the~~  
10 ~~direction provided by the staff of the heart disease and stroke prevention program, the grant~~  
11 ~~recipient shall provide to its member school districts and coordinate with the seven other~~  
12 ~~regional education associations in the state so those associations can provide to their member~~  
13 ~~districts the following:~~

14 ~~— 1. — Activities designed to improve the physical education curricula and the delivery of~~  
15 ~~physical education at the elementary and high school levels;~~

16 ~~— 2. — Hands on instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation to students within the health-~~  
17 ~~curriculum;~~

18 ~~— 3. — Assistance with automated external defibrillator maintenance and readiness-~~  
19 ~~monitoring; and~~

20 ~~— 4. — Any other health related programs identified by the regional education associations~~  
21 ~~and supported by the superintendent of public instruction through the North Dakota~~  
22 ~~coordinated school health program.~~

23 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general  
24 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$160,000, or so much of the

- 1 sum as may be necessary, to the state department of health for the purpose of awarding an  
2 automated external defibrillator maintenance and readiness grant, for the biennium beginning  
3 July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. The grant recipient shall provide training to individuals  
4 in each of the state's regional education associations in order that those individuals:  
5 1. Assist schools located within the boundaries of their respective associations with  
6 automated external defibrillator maintenance and readiness monitoring;  
7 2. Train other staff and students within the boundaries of their respective associations in  
8 the use of automated external defibrillators; and  
9 3. Train other staff and students within the boundaries of their respective associations in  
10 cardiopulmonary resuscitation.
