- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-07 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to school district bullying policies.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

6 Bullying - Required policy.

- 7 <u>1.</u> Each school district shall develop a policy to prohibit the bullying of one student by
 8 another. The policy must include:
- 9a.The procedure to be followed by a student in reporting an alleged act of bullying10to a designated employee at the student's school;
- 11b.The procedure to be followed by school personnel in investigating a report of12alleged bullying:
- 13 <u>c.</u> <u>A procedure for notifying the parents of each student involved in an incident</u>
 14 determined by school personnel to constitute bullying; and
- 15d.Disciplinary measures to be imposed by the student's school if a student is found16to have engaged in bullying.
- 17 <u>2.</u> For purposes of this section, "bullying" means any physical act, verbal utterance, or
- 18 written or electronic communication that is directed toward a student and which:
- 19 <u>a.</u> <u>Causes the student to fear harm to the student's person or property;</u>
- 20 b. Has a detrimental effect on the student's physical or mental health;
- 21 <u>c.</u> Interferes substantially with the student's academic performance; or
- <u>d.</u> Interferes substantially with the student's ability to participate in or benefit from
 services, activities, or privileges provided by a school district.

- 1 <u>3.</u> <u>A policy developed under this section may not impede or preclude a student, the</u>
- 2 <u>student's parents, or school officials from directly reporting to law enforcement officials</u>
- 3 <u>any behavior that constitutes a violation of criminal law under title 12.1.</u>
