- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 29-04-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the commencement of a criminal prosecution; and to repeal sections 29-09-02,
- 3 29-09-06, and 29-09-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to criminal procedure and
- 4 the methods of prosecution.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 29-04-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is

7 amended and reenacted as follows:

8 **29-04-05.** When action prosecution is commenced.

- 9 An information is filed or an indictment found within the meaning of this chapter when it is
- 10 presented, if an information, by the state's attorney or person appointed to prosecute, or, if an-
- 11 indictment, by the grand jury, in open court, and there received and filed, or if a complaint, when
- 12 filed by a magistrate having jurisdiction to hear, try, and determine the action. A prosecution is
- 13 <u>commenced when a uniform complaint and summons, a complaint, or an information is filed or</u>
- 14 when a grand jury indictment is returned.
- 15 SECTION 2. REPEAL. Sections 29-09-02, 29-09-06, and 29-09-07 of the North Dakota
- 16 Century Code are repealed.
