1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-04-12, subsection 1 of section 39-04-18, and

2 <u>subsection 4 of section 39-04-19</u> of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to semitrailer

3 plates; and to provide for application.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-04-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 39-04-12. Contents of number plates - Size of letters and numerals on plates -

8 Reflectorized - Tabs or stickers - Additional fee.

9 1. Number plates must be of metal or other suitable material bearing the name of the 10 state, either in full or by abbreviation, the number of the year, the slogan "Peace 11 Garden State" and a distinctive number for assignment to each vehicle. The distinctive 12 number may be in figures or a combination of figures and letters and must be of a size 13 clearly distinguishable by law enforcement officers and individuals generally. To reduce 14 highway accidents at night all number plates must be legible for a minimum distance 15 of one hundred feet [30.48 meters] to an approaching motorist by day or night with 16 lawful headlight beams and without other illumination. Each plate must be treated with 17 a reflectorized material according to the specifications prescribed by the department. 18 The department shall furnish for each annual registration a year plate, tab, or sticker to 19 designate the year registration. The plate, tab, or sticker must show the registration 20 year for which issued, and is valid only for that year. 21

The department, in its discretion, may provide to an owner of a trailer that is operated,
 offered for lease, or rented to the public, number plates that are for a period of not
 more than six consecutive years and which are exempt from the requirements of

1	entire period for which the plates are issued, or the fee may be paid for the first year of
2	the issue and a corporate surety bond may be filed in the sum the department
3	determines reasonable and adequate in the circumstances, conditioned that the owner-
4	will pay the annual fee at the beginning of each annual registration period. The
5	department shall transfer to a replacement trailer number plates issued pursuant to-
6	this subsection along with any unused registration fees. If the owner has disposed of
7	the trailer and is not replacing the trailer, upon surrender of the number plates the
8	department shall issue a refund of the registration fees paid for any unused
9	registration year.
10	3.—The department may provide to an owner of a fleet of one hundred or more vehicles
11	number plates that are valid for as many as six consecutive years and that are exempt
12	from the requirements of evidence of annual validation. The registrant shall file with
13	the department a corporate surety bond in an amount the department determines to
14	be reasonable and adequate, and conditioned that the owner will pay the annual fee at
15	the beginning of each annual registration period for which the number plates are
16	valid. The department shall provide to an owner of a semitrailer number plates that are
17	valid for the useful life of that semitrailer. Plates provided under this subsection are
18	exempt from the requirements of evidence of annual validation. The registration fee for
19	the semitrailer is fifty dollars which must be paid at the time of registration.
20	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 39-04-18 of the North Dakota Century
21	Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
22	1. Except as provided in this section, every motor vehicle as defined in section 39-01-01,
23	trailer or semitrailer designed to be towed by a truck or truck tractor, and farm trailer
24	operated or intended to be operated upon any highway, road, or street in this state
25	must be registered annually with the department, except that semitrailers must be
26	registered permanently by the department. Any vehicle being operated on highways,
27	roads, or streets of this state must display license plates as furnished by the
28	department upon payment of the fees prescribed in this chapter.
29	Upon satisfactory proof to the department that a motor vehicle owned by a
30	resident of this state was not used upon any of the highways of this state in any one or

1	1	more years, the motor vehicle may be registered upon payment of the registration fee	
2	1	for the current year.	
3		Any resident of the state of North Dakota, serving in the armed forces of the	
4		United States for a period of time greater than one year, may relicense any motor	
5	,	vehicle owned by the veteran without paying any fee or penalties for the intervening	
6	2	years when the vehicle was not licensed, providing the veteran shows by suitable	
7	á	affidavit that the vehicle was not in use during any year in which it was not licensed.	
8	-	The vehicle must be licensed for the license fee applicable to the month of the year in	
9		which application for license is made.	
10	SECT	TION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 39-04-19 of the North Dakota Century	
11	Code is a	mended and reenacted as follows:	
12	4. 1	Every trailer , semitrailer, and farm trailer required to be registered under this chapter	
13	1	must be furnished registration plates upon the payment of a twenty dollar annual fee.	
14	I	Every trailer, semitrailer, or farm trailer not required to be registered under this chapter	
15	1	must be furnished an identification plate upon the payment of a fee of five dollars.	
16	l l	Upon the request of a person with a trailer or farm trailer to whom a registration or	
17	i	dentification plate is provided under this subsection, the department shall provide a	
18	1	plate of the same size as provided for a motorcycle. The department shall provide	
19	1	notification of this option to the person before the replacement or issuance of the plate.	
20	ļ	Every semitrailer required to be registered under this chapter must be furnished	
21	I	permanent registration plates upon the payment of a registration fee of fifty dollars.	
22	-	The registration is valid until ownership of the semitrailer is transferred, assigned, or if	
23	1	the semitrailer is destroyed or otherwise completely removed from the service of the	
24	<u>(</u>	owner.	
25	SECT	ION 4. APPLICATION. Semitrailers that have valid registration maintained for the	
26	previous t	wo years and which originally were registered before August 1, 2009, must be granted-	
27	a number	plate under subsection 2 of section 39-04-12 without additional registration fees.	
28	However, the department may charge an owner a new plate fee of \$5. Semitrailers originally		
29	registered after August 1, 2009, are subject to one-half of the fees provided by subsection 2 of		
30	section 39	9-04-12, and the department may charge an owner a new plate fee of \$5.An owner of	
31	<u>a semitrai</u>	ler newly registered after August 1, 2011, shall pay the fees provided in section 3 of

- 1 this Act. The owner of a currently registered semitrailer on August 1, 2011, shall renew
- 2 registration and pay the fees provided in section 3 of this Act before January 1, 2012, and may
- 3 receive a reduction in the fee and, notwithstanding any other provision of law, a refund of
- 4 previously paid unused registration fees.
