- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the attendance of mature students at institutions of higher education.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
and enacted as follows:

6	Mate	ure students - Attendance at institutions of higher education.
7	<u>1.</u>	a. Any resident of this state who is at least fifty-fivesixty-five years of age may
8		attend for credit or audit any undergraduate course or class offered by an
9		institution of higher education under the control of the state board of higher
10		education without a charge of tuition or fees, and without having to demonstrate
11		the achievement of certain academic thresholds normally required of students.
12		b. Subdivision a does not extend to any online course or class.
13	<u>2.</u>	Notwithstanding subsection 1, any student duly admitted to the institution must be
14		given priority with respect to enrollment in courses or classes having a maximum
15		allowable enrollment.
16	<u>3.</u>	An institution may not employ additional staff or increase the availability of courses or
17		classes based solely on interest expressed by students referenced in subsection 1.
18	<u>4.</u>	If a student referenced in subsection 1 successfully completes the requirements of any
19		course or class attended for credit in accordance with this section, the student shall be
20		awarded academic credit by the institution.
21	<u>5.</u>	All books, supplies, and expenses other than tuition and fees are the responsibility of
22		the student.
