1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for the control of Johne's disease.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

3 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general 4 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$275,000, or so much of the 5 sum as may be necessary, to the agriculture commissioner to aid in controlling Johne's disease 6 in this state, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. The 7 commissioner may award grants to livestock producers who participate in the North Dakota 8 voluntary Johne's disease herd status program in order to defray expenses incurred by the 9 producers in testing and controlling Johne's disease and may provide information to producers 10 and veterinarians about efforts to control Johne's disease. This appropriation is not subject to 11 section 54-44.1-11.
