- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the North Dakota teacher of the year award.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

6	Nor	th Dakota teacher of the year award - Selection - Announcement.
7	<u>1.</u>	Annually, the superintendent of public instruction shall accept nominations for the
8		North Dakota teacher of the year award.
9	<u>2.</u>	The superintendent of public instruction shall develop and publish the criteria by which
10		all nominees must be considered and shall appoint an eight-membera committee to
11		review the nominations and select the North Dakota teacher of the year. The
12		committee must consist of:
13		a. A former North Dakota teacher of the year award recipient;
14		b. <u>A representative of the North Dakota council of educational leaders;</u>
15		c. A representative of the North Dakota department of career and technical
16		education;
17		d. <u>A representative of the North Dakota department of public instruction;</u>
18		e. <u>A representative of the North Dakota education association;</u>
19		f. <u>A representative of the North Dakota home school association;</u>
20	!	g.f. <u>A representative of the North Dakota school boards association; and</u>
21	Ł	e. A representative of nonpublic schools in this state.
22	<u>3.</u>	During September of each year, the superintendent of public instruction shall host in
23		the memorial hall of the state capitol a ceremony at which the award recipient is
24		announced.

1	3.	The teacher of the year award recipient must be announced during the annual
2		convention of the North Dakota education association. At a mutually agreeable time
3		after the annual convention, the governor and the superintendent of public instruction
4		jointly shall host a ceremony at which the award recipient is recognized.
