1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subdivision to subsection 3 of section 39-12-02 and
2 a new subsection to section 39-12-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to special
3 permits for oversize and overweight vehicles and a motor carrier electronic permit transaction
4 fund; ~~and to provide for a continuing appropriation;~~ and to declare an emergency.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1.** A new subdivision to subsection 3 of section 39-12-02 of the North Dakota
7 Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

8 The highway patrol may establish an online electronic permit system. If the
9 highway patrol establishes an online electronic permit system, the highway patrol
10 shall assess an additional fifteen dollar fee for every permit issued under this
11 section to be deposited into the motor carrier electronic permit transaction fund.

12 **SECTION 2.** A new subsection to section 39-12-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
13 created and enacted as follows:

14 There is created in the state treasury a fund known as the motor carrier electronic
15 permit transaction fund. All money in the fund is appropriated on a continuing basis to
16 the highway patrol to defray the costs of establishing and maintaining an online
17 electronic permit system for permitting and routing oversize and overweight vehicles in
18 this state. The highway patrol may contract with a private entity to establish, operate,
19 and maintain an online electronic permit system. The online electronic permit system
20 includes the issuance of permits under this section and an automated routing system.
21 The automated routing system must include integration of department of transportation
22 traveler information system information, all other data required for the automated
23 routing system, and integration of the highway patrol computer-aided dispatch system.

24 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
