## 1 A BILL for an Act to establish a demonstration plant incentive grant program to produce

2 transportation biofuel from sugar-based feedstock; and to provide a contingent appropriation.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

## 4 SECTION 1. SUGAR-BASED FEEDSTOCK BIOFUEL DEMONSTRATION PLANT

5 INCENTIVE GRANT PROGRAM - INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION. During the 2011-13 biennium,

6 the industrial commission shall establish and administer a program to provide a grant to a

7 qualified applicant for the purpose of assisting the applicant with the costs associated with

8 acquiring or constructing facilities for, and operating, a demonstration plant to determine the

9 technological and economic attributes of producing transportation biofuel from multiple sugar

10 based feedstock. A grant awarded under this program may not exceed \$7,000,000.

SECTION 2. CONTINGENT APPROPRIATION. Subject to the industrial commission
certifying to the office of management and budget that an applicant has qualified for a grant,

13 there is appropriated out of any moneys in the resources trust fund in the state treasury, not

- 14 otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$7,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to
- 15 the industrial commission for the purpose of providing a sugar-based feedstock biofuel
- 16 demonstration plant incentive grant in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of this Act, for
- 17 the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.
