- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for the department of commerce to conduct a sugar-based
- 2 feedstock biofuel demonstration plant feasibility study; and to provide an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. SUGAR-BASED FEEDSTOCK BIOFUEL DEMONSTRATION PLANT

5 **FEASIBILITY STUDY**.

- During the 2011-13 interim, the department of commerce shall conduct a sugar-based
 feedstock biofuel demonstration plant feasibility study.
- 8 2. The feasibility study must:
- 9 a. Address the cost of a sugar-based feedstock biofuel demonstration plant;
- b. Determine the nature and scope of existing and potential markets, both domestic
 and international, for sugar-based feedstock biofuel;
- 12 c. Review federal laws, regulations, policies, and guidelines regarding biofuels; and
- d. Examine the potential for obtaining loans, grants, and other incentives in order to
 further the development of a sugar-based feedstock biofuel demonstration plant.
- The department of commerce shall report its findings and recommendations, together
 with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-third
 legislative assembly.
- 18 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
- 19 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$5,000, or so much of the sum
- 20 as may be necessary, to the department of commerce for the purpose of conducting a
- 21 sugar-based feedstock biofuel demonstration plant feasibility study as provided under section 1
- of this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.
