

**HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3020**

1 A concurrent resolution congratulating the North Dakota Highway Patrol on its 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

2 **WHEREAS**, the Highway Patrol was created by the 1935 Legislative Assembly, and in 1936  
3 five Highway Police were appointed by the Highway Patrol superintendent; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the duty to enforce the provisions of law relating to the protection and use of  
5 public highways in this state and the operation of motor vehicles on the highways was  
6 expanded to include the enforcement of all criminal laws on highways in 1967; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the responsibilities of the Highway Patrol were expanded to include the  
8 operation of the law enforcement training center in 1971; and

9 **WHEREAS**, all security duties for the Capitol were placed under the direction of the  
10 Highway Patrol in 2005; and

11 **WHEREAS**, since 1962 the Highway Patrol has provided two troopers to attend the  
12 American Legion's North Dakota Boys State as counseling staff; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the Highway Patrol and the North Dakota Motor Carriers Association are jointly  
14 involved in selecting the trooper of the year and the motor carrier driver of the year;

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF**  
16 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

17 That the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly congratulates the North Dakota Highway Patrol  
18 on its 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this resolution  
20 to the Governor, the superintendent of the Highway Patrol, the state office of the American  
21 Legion, and the North Dakota Motor Carriers Association.
