1 A concurrent resolution for the amendment of section 4 of article XI of the Constitution of North

2 Dakota, relating to oaths of office of elected and appointed officials.

STATEMENT OF INTENT

4 This amendment provides that members of the executive branch are required to take the oath

5 prescribed by this section.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE

- 7 SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 8 That the following proposed amendment to section 4 of article XI of the Constitution of
- 9 North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the
- 10 general election to be held in 2012, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the
- 11 Constitution of North Dakota.

12 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 4 of article XI of the Constitution of North Dakota is

- 13 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 14 **Section 4.** Members of the legislative assembly and <u>the executive and</u> judicial
- 15 department<u>branches</u>, except such inferior officers as may be by law exempted shall, before they
- 16 enter on the duties of their respective offices, shall take and subscribe the following oath or
- 17 affirmation: "I do solemnly swear (or affirm as the case may be) that I will support the
- 18 Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of North Dakota; and that I
- 19 will faithfully discharge the duties of the office of ______ according to the best of my ability,
- 20 so help me God" (if an oath), (under pains and penalties of perjury) if an affirmation, and noany
- 21 other oath, declaration, or test shall<u>may not</u> be required as a qualification for any office or public
- 22 trust.
