- 1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study the feasibility and
- 2 desirability of requiring use of cigarette tax stamps.
- 3 WHEREAS, North Dakota is one of only three states that do not require tax stamps on
- 4 cigarettes; and
- 5 WHEREAS, a study of the feasibility and desirability of requiring tax stamping on cigarettes
- 6 will allow consideration of the benefits and detriments of requiring cigarette tax stamps on the
- 7 state, wholesalers, the public, and administrative and law enforcement agencies;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF

9 NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

- 10 That the Legislative Management study the feasibility and desirability of requiring use of
- 11 cigarette tax stamps; and
- 12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
- 13 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 14 the Sixty-third Legislative Assembly.
