- 3 **WHEREAS**, public health services are essential in promoting a healthy workforce to rapidly
- 4 growing communities in Indian country; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service faces a possible decline in funding; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the Fort Berthold Reservation encompasses portions of six counties and is
- 7 served by at least three public health units which results in funding problems;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE

9 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

- 10 That the Legislative Management study the feasibility and desirability of placing the entire
- 11 Fort Berthold Reservation in a single public health unit; and
- 12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
- 13 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 14 the Sixty-third Legislative Assembly.
